

COVID-19 Reopening Protocol

1. Entrance into the church will be through the main **north** entrance only – all other doors will remain locked.
2. **Masks are required** for everyone entering the building, ages 3 and up. The mask should stay on, **covering your mouth and nose**, from the time you exit your vehicle until the time you re-enter your vehicle.
3. Social distancing (6 feet apart) on church property at all times.
4. Everyone will be asked to use hand sanitizer upon entering the building.
5. Use of the elevator to the balcony will be limited to one family unit at a time.
6. There will be no coffee or donut service. During this time, please do not bring food or drink into the building.
7. Staff and volunteers will be assisting with seating inside the sanctuary to help maintain social distancing. Please maintain distancing while exiting the sanctuary.
8. All items have been removed from the pew backs (Bibles, hymnals, pencils, note cards, etc.)
9. Offering boxes have been placed at the back of the sanctuary and near the Welcome Desk for offering as the congregation leaves worship.
10. Pastors and music staff will wear masks on the chancel (stage), except when speaking or singing. Seating at the front of the sanctuary will begin several pews from the front.
11. The Cry Room will be closed. The atrium hallway will be available for young families with children who need to leave the sanctuary during worship.
12. Please maintain social distancing protocols in restrooms. The restrooms behind the Welcome Desk will be available for use.
13. The church offices will be closed to visitors.
14. During this time, communion will not be served in the sanctuary.
15. Following CDC guidelines, we encourage those at high-risk to continue to worship online.
16. If you are feeling ill, please stay home.
